

#### **CRITERIA**

raison d'être continues unaltered to this day. Each year we adopt a single charity doing remarkable work and aim to transform its fortunes. The fundraising takes place around our annual dinner and we are immensely grateful to our supporters, both personal and corporate who give so generously. While there is no formal system of membership all attendees of our dinners become de facto members of the Club. Many have often asked how we select our charities and it is therefore opportune to offer a brief explanation of the process used each year.

Simply put, our aim is to select a charity doing remarkable work who can clearly demonstrate how our financial contribution will be used to transform their fortunes. With this in mind we offer the following minimum requirements to be considered for selection:

- 1. The charity must demonstrate how making use of The October Club's financial support could transform its prospects.
- 2. The charity must be able to make full use of the funds raised within a maximum of three years.
- 3. Funding is to be used for one (or more) specific transformational project and not to top up a general appeal.
- 4. Funding will be used for UK based projects.
- 5. The charity must be operating in several regions in the UK or will be, post October Club funding.
- 6. The charity must demonstrate that it has received an income of between £500,000 and £2,500,000 from voluntary sources. By 'voluntary sources' we mean donations from Trusts, corporations, individuals and legacies.

Some of the charities chosen in the past have been introduced by members of the Club and this is welcomed. Inevitably with only one winner, there are always disappointments, but one of the keys to our success and longevity is that we deliver a first rate cause to each dinner.

As a member reading this page, if you know of a charity that meets with these criteria, please consider encouraging them to apply for funding. Please bear in mind that we are unlikely to fund a charity whose cause is the same as that of one of our selected charities of the past two years. We will be open to applications in Q1 2020, please check the website for closing dates.



#### **Specialists** make the difference

£44,833 funds a Nurse Specialist for a year to directly support spinal cord injured patients and train their carers. We are looking for pledges for at least two more Nurse Specialists for the three years of the project, who will provide hundreds of spinal cord injured patients with the expert care essential to meeting their vital basic healthcare needs and to rebuild their lives.



#### The Hub keeps it evolving

£20,539 is the annual cost to make our central Triage Nurse a full-time post. This pivotal role, at the centre of the project's hub and spoke model, will support the expanded Nurse Specialist team and amplify the impact of the charity's wider range of services.



#### Communication makes it collaborative

£10,000 pays for the production and distribution of digital and printed materials for each of the three years. This is critical for the assessment forms, treatment and care plans, training materials and project reports, and information brochures for each of the specialist nurses.



#### **Knowledge** makes it cutting edge

£2,000 provides the expanded Nurse Specialist team with the latest knowledge and skills, for each year of the project. This optimises the highest standard of care to patients and expert training for all professionals.



#### **Tools** make it practical

£1,000 buys an anatomical model used to train healthcare professionals. This is very specific to spinal cord injury and helps nursing and care staff to understand how to meet essential healthcare needs, for example, bladder and bowel care.

#### **Evidence** makes it sustainable

£104,246 covers the three-year cost of the design and evaluation strand of the project. Strong evidence will provide a compelling case to shape national policy and leverage additional investment. The result will mean systemic, sustainable impact beyond the threeyear project.



#### Education makes it scaleable

£20,000 funds a vital national educational event to transform the awareness and commitment of healthcare professionals, service providers and decision makers.



#### Travel makes it accessible

£5,000 covers the annual travel costs of the entire Nurse Specialist team. This allows us to provide direct face to face support to spinal cord injured patients and their carers in their homes and in non-specialist settings.



#### **Equipment** makes it efficient

£1,500 equips each Nurse Specialist with the technology and communications needed to carry out their role. This includes a bespoke tablet, specialist software, and a mobile phone linked to our cloud-based database.



#### Technology makes it future proof

Our ability to support more spinal cord injured people will be transformed by upgrading our archaic IT and hardware systems across all frontline and central office staff. This goes beyond nurses and out to peer support officers, counsellors, advocacy teams, campaigners and right through to our compliance, finance and fundraising departments. The funding required to bring this to a fully operable standard is £45,000.

In recent years, he has found his true comfort zone in capturing the animal and human world in a fresh and creative way, with philanthropy and conservation central to his passion to document. In 2018, charitable donations from the sale of David's images exceeded \$2 million.

Yarrow's photography of life on earth is most distinctive and it has earned him an ever growing following amongst art collectors. Yarrow is now represented by some of the top contemporary fine art galleries around the world and in the last two years, three of Yarrow's works have sold for over \$100,000 at Sotheby's auctions in London and New York.

**SQUAD** – "To find two of the world's remaining 20 big tusker elephants side by side was a huge privilege and I felt a responsibility to get it right. Tim and Craig are colossal mammals and dominated a formidable front line of big bulls that morning in Amboseli. To be so close to two of the biggest elephants in the world and photographing from the ground up was as intense a 30 seconds in the field as I can remember. I was fortunate with the soft light and the background both of which were out of my control. We were packed up and celebrating back at camp by 8.30 am.

This is probably my lead shot of 2019 and I am deeply grateful to my guide - Juma Wanyama - without which it would not have been possible. Not only does he facilitate my partnership with the street smart Masai spotters whom I asked to search for Tim and Craig at first light, he has also helped develop my working relationship with the Kenyan Wildlife Service (KWS) who oversee and support my work in Amboseli. It is not on paper, but I believe that the considerable sums we give back to conservation in Africa (over \$1m a year) helps our cause with the KWS.

However, Juma's key skill is his understanding of the mood of both Tim and Craig and their willingness to tolerate my presence in their space. He worked wonders to allow this epic encounter to materialise. I have total trust in Juma and I think he also knows, after eight years of working together, that I am responsible when out of the jeep. One cavalier move could be fatal.
