## THE CAUSE

Over the past 37 years, The October Club's annual events have raised a total of nearly £17 million for UK-based charities. Each year, The October Club's committee invites applications from small and medium-sized charities that are looking to extend the scope of what they do. Following a rigorous assessment process, it selects one that is doing remarkable work and has a compelling transformational project plan, ensuring that the funds raised that year impact lives directly.

The October Club's past causes have ranged widely from charities with a physical or mental health focus, such as Parkinsons, spinal injuries or eating disorders, to those that seek to reach disadvantaged or marginalised people and provide them with skills and confidence to reach their potential.

In 2024, The October Club's fundraising events raised more than £690,000 for our charity of the year, Back Up, a spinal cord injury charity. 2025 will bring another exceptional cause to the forefront.

The number of applications received in 2025 is the highest in the Club's history, featuring many outstanding charities with transformational project plans. We expect to announce our charity partner for 2025 in late May or early June.
